Area of Operation: - This trust Operation shall be National level (ALL OVER 2. INDIA).


2. OBJECTS / GUIDELINES OF THE TRUST ARE:


ENVIRONMENT:

- 27) Inspire change in youngsters by educating and cultivating change through The power of sport.
- 28) Ensure improvement in life of youths through charitable and sporting activities.
- . 29) Ensure providing sports facilities to youth after schools and college and to ensure their non-diversions towards harmful activities like drugs and other anti-

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social activities.

- 30) Promote social, cultural, health and sports events.
- 31) Organize charitable events for the advancement of the poor, needy and deserving people.
- 32)Encourage youth to engage in sporting activities so that to make them stay away from drugs and other bad habits and to utilizing their time for sports activities.

The Trustee shall appoint one among them as Managing Trustee of the Board of Trustee.


The Trustees of the Trust may obtain payments of money from all courts and departments of the State and Central Governments including local authority or authorities and also funds gathering from NRIs.

- 5. The non-appointment of any trustee shall not invalidate the trust or any action taken or done on behalf of the trust.
- 6. The day-to-day a conduct and management of the affairs of the trust shall be carried on by Sri.VISWANADHAPALLI NAGA SUNDARAM who shall be known as the Managing Trustees. The other trustees will co-operative with them to carry out the aims and objectives of the trust. The Managing Trustees will have the perfect control over the trust.
- 7. The Managing Trustees are entitled to appoint additional trustee or trustees not exceeding three numbers and also fix the terms of their appointment. Any vacancy in the additional trustees may be filled up by the Managing Trustees Sri.VISWANADHAPALLI NAGA SUNDARAM

8. PROPERTIES VESTED IN THE TRUST:

- Sixteen only) mentioned above as the initial money set apart for the trust by the Author and taken possession of by the Trustees, they shall also stand possess of by the trustees, they shall also stand possess of any other capital money and properties which the trustees may from time to time acquire or receive in future by way of gifts, donations or receipts which may be augmenting the trust and such donations or receipts which may be accepted for fulfilling one or the several objects of the trust as indicated by the author of the trust.
- ii) All the funds of the trust and the income arising from the investments of the trust shall be credited into the corpus fund and applied for the purpose of the trust in such a manner as the trustees shall from time to time decided at the meeting, in

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accordance with the objectives of the trust.

- iii) Except the Corpus fund there are no movable and immovable properties in the name of the trust as on this date:
- 9. THE POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES ARE AS UNDER:
- i) The trustees shall hold the properties of the Trust for the objects stated herein.
- ii) The number of trustees shall in no case exceed seven and shall in no case of be less than three. The management committee of the trust will consist of Author/president, Secretary and Treasurer.
- iii) The President shall preside over the meetings of the Board of Trustees and in his absence; his nominee shall preside over the said meetings.
- iv) The General body of the Trust shall meet once in a year in the month of January. It may meet even within one year on demand of circumstances.
- v) The managing trustee or by his appointment any other trustee shall have the power to acquire capital assets for the purpose of the trust and likewise have the power to dispose them off.
- vi) The managing trustee is authorized to invest the funds of the trust in accordance with the provisions of the income tax act, 1961 and rules and thereunder from time to time.
- vii) The managing trustee is entitled to collect any fees by himself or by his appointment by one or more of the trust members for carrying out of the objects of the trust. But, such collection shall be only to meet the actual expenses without any element of profit.
- viii) The Trustees may reimburse themselves and pay and charge out of the trust fund all expenses incurred to them in or about the execution of the trust or any of their duties under these presents including traveling expenses but will not be entitled to any remuneration.
- ix) The quorum of meeting of the Board of trustees shall three.
- x) The Board of Trustees shall meet as often as necessary.
- xi) The Board of Trustees shall have the power to frame rules and regulations from time to time for facilitating and carrying out of the objects of the Trust.
- 10. THE TRUSTEES MAY AND ARE HEREBY EMPOWERED TO:
- a) The trust is entitled to acquire by gift, purchase, exchange, lease or otherwise lands, buildings or other immovable properties together will all rights appur-

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tenant there to in the name of the Trust.


- b) To construct and maintain buildings, including the right to add, alter, improve them and equip them suitably.
- c) To raise funds and receive gifts and donations if necessary for carrying out the progress and objectives of the Trust.
- To incur necessary expenses for carrying out the aims and objects of the Trust.
- e) Donations receive from friends, missions and organizations in India and other abroad nations for the development of the trust activities.
- f) To employ the necessary staff and or to terminate their services.
- g) To appoint Chartered Accountant, Legal Advisor, Sub-committees, Advisory Committee for all or any one of its managing Institutions and they may delegate their powers to such bodies or others or to some of their members on such terms and conditions as they deem fit.
- h) The Trustees may reimburse themselves and pay and charge out of the trust fund all expenses incurred to them in or about the execution of the trust or any of their duties under these presents including traveling expenses but will not be entitled to any remuneration.
- i) The Trust is authorized to invest the funds of the trust in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act 1961 and rules and there under from time to time.

DUTIES OF PRESIDENT:

- a. He shall preside over all the meetings of the Board of Trustees. If he is unable to preside over the meetings on account of his being out of the city or sickness, his nominee from the Board of Trustees shall preside over the meetings.
- b. It is always open to the President to delegate any of his powers to any office bearer or any Trustee.
- c. He shall be the custodian of all Bank Accounts and financial matters relating to the Trust and shall also arrange for all accounts to be audited by Chartered Accountant.
- d. He shall operate Bank Account on the name of the Founder/President and shall cause all accounts of all branches duly audited by Chartered Accountant

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with the help of the Treasurer.

e. He shall have power to sanction the proposed expenditure for all activities of the Trust and inspect all the records and accounts of the Trust from time to time.

DUTIES OF THE SECRETARY:

- a. he shall keep acquainted with all the aspects of the functioning of the Trust.
- b. he shall prepare agendas for the meetings of Board of Trustees in consultation with the President and shall assist the president in all matters.
- c. he shall maintain records of minutes of all meetings of Board of Trustees.
- d. he shall be responsible for submitting the audited accounts to the Government and Income Tax Department as per the existing rules.
- e. he shall be the custodian of all records and documents of the Trust and shall visit the centers of the Trust as per the need and made or cause to be made inspection of records, documents and etc., for proper and fair functioning of the Trust.

DUTIES OF TREASURER:

- a. He shall assist the Secretary in all money matters.
- b. He shall keep and maintain proper accounts.
- c. He shall arrange for all accounts to be audited by Chartered Accountant at the advice of the Secretary.

11. FUNDS:

The funds of the Trust shall comprise:

- 1. Donations, gifts, received from or through individuals philanthropists, general public, Institutions, foundations, Voluntary Organizations, and etc.,
- 2. Endowments in favour of the Trust.
- 3. Grants from the Funding organizations either from the India or Abroad nations.
- 4. Income from the properties of the Trust.
- 5. Any other income which may accrue in the working of any other institutions controlled by the Trust.
- 6. The finance shall be spent only for the attainment of the objects of the Trust.
- 7. The Trust should endeavor to use donations and gifts as designated. However any given need is being met, the Trust reserves the right to distribute the funds where it believes the need is greatest and where it can more efficiently

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accomplish its aims and objects.

12. BANK ACCOUNTS:

A Bank account shall be opened in the name of the Trust in any of the Banks by the Founder/President as may be authorized in the Board of Trustees from time to time in writing for their purposes.

13. ACCOUNTS AND MINUTES:

The Trustees shall maintain true and correct accounts of all receipts and dealings in regard to the Trust property and shall also maintain correct record of their meetings and deliberations. Accounts shall be audited by Chartered Accountant every year. The accounting year shall be from 1st April to 31st March every year.

14. The aims and objects of the Trust as set forth in object clause, and the governing rules may be amended, or a proposal and approval of the Founder/ President/Chairman and in consultation with the Board of Executive Members, however that may any such alterations, modifications or amendments shall not have the effect of violation of provision of the Trust Act or Sec.80G of the Income Tax Act, or any statutory notification thereof for the time being In force and prior approval of the Commissioner of the Income Tax shall be obtained.

15. CESSATION OF TRUSTEESHIP:

- a) The Trustee shall cease to be trustee and also cease to hold office if any held, if he resigns dies, becomes unsound in mind, physically unfit, is adjudicated insolvent or is convicted of Criminal offence involving moral turpitude.
- b) In the event of the conduct of any trustee appearing to be likely to endanger the stability or to disturb the harmony of or order of the trust or in case of any serious infractions by a Trustee of this deed of rules of the trust, meeting shall be called by the President in order to consider the matter. If not, fewer than three Trustees present at such meeting decide by the resolution of the expulsion of any trustee, he shall cease to be a Trustee upon the communication of the decision to him writing.

16. AMENDMENT:

Any amendment to this document shall be affected in respect of the provisions applicable to the Trustees and other matters. Provided no alterations or amendments shall be carried out without the proper prior approval of Commissioner of

Income Tax.

17. **DISSOLUTION:**

In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust, the assets remaining as on the date of the dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the Trustees. But the same shall be transferred to nominee/Dependent of the Founder/ President of the Trust or institution whose objects and faith are similar to those of the Trust and which is registered under Section 12A of the Income Tax Act 1961.
